## Swain House Primary School Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club is based in the main hall with the doors opening at either 7.30am prompt or 7.45am. From 8.00am the children are split into groups with one group remaining in the Main Hall and the others taken to other areas of school (Library, Food Technology room, Small Hall, Piazza) for the morning activity with their allocated member of staff. Each member of staff has a timetabled area and the activities are confirmed on a weekly basis.

The regular daily activities in Breakfast Club include:

- Story time, reading and using computers in the Library
- Circle games or sports in the Small Hall
- Arts and craft activities in the Main Hall
- Cooking and baking in the Food Technology room
- Board games in the Main Hall
- Outdoor games on the Piazza

Every Friday all of the children stay together in the main hall to watch a DVD.

Each half term we have various special activities which all of the children can take part in. These activities are themed around an event or occasion that is taking place during the coming weeks such as Christmas, Chinese New Year, Easter and Red Nose Day. At the end of each term we have a party and the children who attend Breakfast Club make decorations and prepare special breakfast treats for the party.

We offer a healthy breakfast menu in keeping with our healthy school ethos. Our menu includes a variety of cereals, yoghurts, fruit juices, fresh fruit, toast, crumpets and scrambled eggs.

Children from Nursery through to Year 6 are welcome to attend Breakfast Club at a cost of £2.50 per day for the 7.30am prompt start or £2.00 per day for the 7.45am onwards start. Places are limited and do require booking in advance via the main office. These can be booked for the full year, termly, half termly, weekly or daily in advance.

## Swain House Primary School After School Club/Extra Club

Our After School Club runs daily from 3.00-4.00pm at a cost of £2.00 per day and our Extra Club runs from 4.00-5.30pm at a cost of £4.00 per day. If you would like your child to attend our After School club you will need to book a place for them with the main office before 2.00pm. Places for our Extra Club need to be booked and paid for in advance. These places for either club can be booked on a weekly, half termly or termly basis.

After School Club activities include playing various sports, arts and crafts, games and watching DVDs.
