What is a social network?

Social networks are websites, games or apps that allow people to interact with each other, and share things.

Users create a profile and can:

- share photos and images
- message each other (sometimes in a group)
- chat with people via video
- make voice calls
- share content
- meet new people and chat to strangers
- play games.
