

Today's English will be all about colons! We can use a colon for two reasons.

- 1) To introduce a list- however, the sentence before the colon should still make sense

For example:

Henry went on a walk with Miss Brow; he needed: his harness, his coat, poo bags and treats.

Not

Henry's walk: harness, his coat, poo bags and treats.

- 2) To add an explanation

We all know who the funniest teacher in schools is: Miss Brow!
