


MRS PUGH'S AFTERNOON TEA

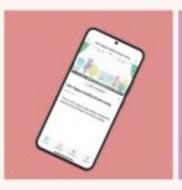
