Here are a few of the fairytale stories we are going to be reading. The Three Little Pigs, The Gingerbread Man, Goldilocks and the Three Bears and Jack, and the Beanstalk. Alongside exploring the fun activities, children will be practicing their counting skills and learning about shapes and colours.
