

Multiplication

Multiply a 2 digit number by a single digit number

To know by heart the 3, 4 & 8 times table facts

$$39 \times 4 = 156$$

Remember to:

- Write one digit per square
- Write each digit in the correct place value column (T, O)
- Start multiplying from the right (9×4)
- Write the answer between the answer lines below
- Write the ones digit of the answer (6) between the answer lines and regroup the other digit to the column to the left.
- Write the regrouped digit (3) below the answer lines.
- Multiply the next digit from the right (3×4) and repeat the steps above.
- Add the regrouped digit to the multiplication answer if there is one (E.G $3 \times 4 = 12$ PLUS the regrouped 3 = 15).
