Concrete representation

Things you can pick up and move, for example, dice, counters, shells, pebbles, buttons and straws...You can use any objects that you have at home too!

Pictorial representation

A picture to represent mathematics, such as a calculation (printed in books or drawn)

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<u>Abstract representation</u> Numbers 1, 2, 3, 4 and symbols +, -, x, ÷, <, >, = etc.
