This half term our theme is **Down at the Bottom of the Garden.**

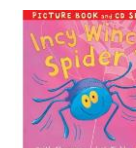
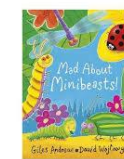
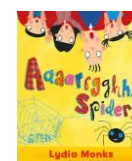
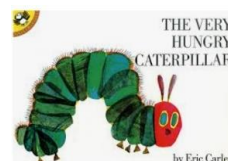
