Amazing Animals!

This half term our theme is 'Amazing Animals'. We will be learning all about animals for different parts of the world, from jungle animals to arctic animals. We will also be having a pet week and talking about the animals that some of the children might have at home!

In mathematics this half term, we will be continuing our learning of numbers from I-5 and starting to learn about numbers 6-10. We will continue identifying 2D and 3D shapes and exploring repeating patterns, We will be using objects, singing number rhymes and looking at number in the environment. We will also be comparing the size and weight of objects.

Books linked to our theme

Books we are going to read linked to our theme are:











Core Books and Rhymes

We have been developing the use of 'core reading' books in nursery.

We have chosen books that are repetitive, predictable and often feature rhyme. This makes it easier for children to join in with, so that the experience of reading becomes interactive and the children begin to learn the story as they are read to. We have also selected books that will gain children's interests and help them to obtain knowledge of the world around them.

This half term our core books are:

- The Tiger Who Came To Tea
- We're Going on a Bear Hunt

This half term our core rhymes are:

- Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear
- Here comes the Terrible Crocodile...

How you can help your child at home

Share story books with your child at home; the time you spend sharing a book with your child is invaluable and makes a huge difference to their development.

Encourage your child to count at home e.g. count steps as you walk up and down, count teddies, count cars etc.

Talk to your child about what they have been learning at nursery. Encourage turn taking whilst talking and ask them questions which include who, what, why and when.

Remember to fill in our 'Star Moment' cards when your child does something they are proud of at home. For example: Chloe swam without arm bands during her swimming lesson this weekend.

Messages

Please remember to bring a labelled water bottle to nursery and a rucksack with nappies, wipes and spare clothing. Please add extra clothing if your child is toilet training.

We are trying to encourage children to not bring their own toys to nursery as things can get lost or broken.
