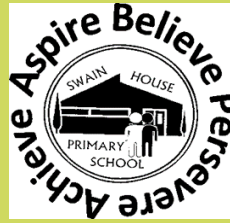

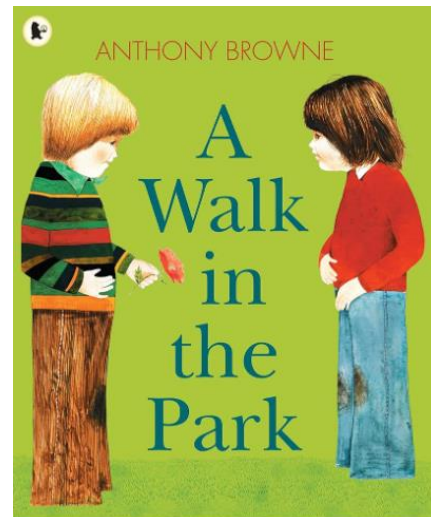
Tuesday 26th November 2024
